Don't click on links unless you are waiting for something specific, and watch for spelling used in any correspondence. If you are ever in doubt, ignore the email or text and call the company from which you supposedly got the message.

The Banker's Banquet Recipes

Blueberry Coffee Cake

Cake Ingredients:

- 3 Cups Flour
- 1 Cup Sugar
- 1 tsp Salt
- 1 tsp Baking Soda
- 1 tsp Baking Powder
- 1 Cup Soft Butter
- 1 Cup Buttermilk
- 2 Eggs
- 1 tsp Vanilla
- 2 Cups Blueberries

Topping Ingredients:

- ¾ Cup Sugar
- ¼ Cup Soft Butter
- ½ Cup Flour
- ½ tsp Cinnamon

Directions:

Stir together all dry cake ingredients, then cut in 1 cup butter. Once mixed, add buttermilk, eggs, vanilla, and blueberries. Stir until moistened and pour into a 9x13 baking pan. Mix together topping ingredients and sprinkle on top of cake mixture. Bake at 350 degrees for 30-40 minutes. Serve and enjoy!
