## The Banker's Banquet Recipes

### Cinnamon Popcorn

#### Ingredients:

- 8 Quarts Popped Popcorn
- 1 Cup Butter, cubed
- ½ Cup Light Corn Syrup
- 1 Package (9 oz) Red Hots Candies



#### Directions:

Place popcorn in a large bowl; set aside. In a large saucepan, combine the butter, corn syrup, and candies; bring to a boil over medium heat, stirring constantly. Boil for 5 minutes, stirring occasionally. Pour over popcorn and toss to coat.

Transfer to 2 greased 15x10x1-inch baking pans. Bake at 250° for 1 hour, stirring every 15 minutes. Remove from pans and place on waxed paper to cool. Break apart; store in airtight containers.
